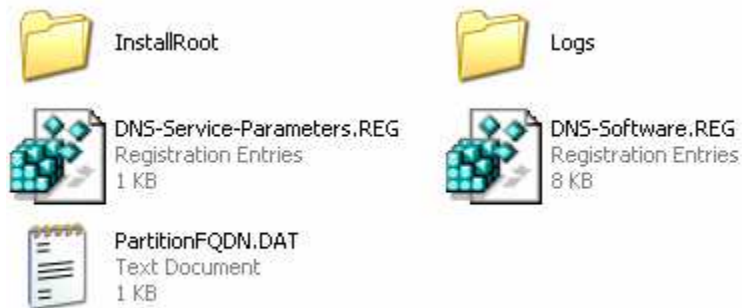


## **DNS Restore Procedure using DNSDUMP.CMD**

- 1) This should be done on a clean DNS Installation, meaning no zones should currently exist on the server. If you have anything set on the server level such as forwarders don't worry about it as it will be overwritten.
- 2) Create a folder in the root of the C drive called "**DNSRestore**" and copy DNSDUMP.CMD into that folder
- 3) Copy the "**BackupData**" folder to the root of the C: drive, preferably with no spaces such as the name used here.  
The contents of the "**BackupData**" folder should look like this:



- 4) Go to a command line and switch to the "**DNSRestore**" folder in the root of your C: drive.
- 5) Type **DNSDUMP import C:\DNSRestore\BackupData** and press enter
- 6) This will restore your saved DNS data and configuration
